NEW MEMBERS SECTION

For those of you tackling their first season of Football, here are a few things you need to know.

1. Matches are played on Saturday with the Competition set to begin on 10th April for Seniors and 17th April for Junior & Youth grades and continuing through until the last week of August. Most matches are played within South Auckland & Parents are expected to organise their own children’s transport. Senior Women play on Sunday starting 11th April.
2. Training sessions are held at Mountfort Park, usually on a Tues, Wed, or Thurs. The actual day will be decided by your team. The first training session for “children’s teams” is scheduled for the week commencing 8th March.
3. Dependent on the parent help within your team, you may also be asked to contribute \$1 - \$2 per week to cover ½ time drinks, food, and end of year activities.
4. Shirts & Shorts are provided by the club, free of charge. However, every player needs to purchase his or her own socks. These are available from the clubrooms at \$20 per pair.
5. Your Coach and/or Manager will ensure you are well-informed “week-by-week” of club activities, training requirements, and other special events to be held at the Clubroom.
6. We know that with your enthusiasm and support, you are now ready to play hard but fair and someone will be in contact with you soon to let you know which team you will be in.

Playing fees for the 2010 season are as follows:

5th & 6th Grade Small Whites	\$65.00
Juniors – 6th Grade up to 11th Grade	\$80.00
Youth – 12th Grade up to U19	\$95.00
Secondary/Tertiary Students playing Senior Grades	\$130.00
Senior Players – Women & Men	\$190.00
Family Discount <i>(where two or more family members play)</i> Juniors, Youth & Students	\$5.00 <i>(per player)</i>
Seniors	\$50.00 <i>(per player)</i>

All fees are due at the time of registration, unless prior arrangements are authorised by the Committee. EFTPOS is available at the clubrooms. In the event your child decides that Football is not for them, before 20 March, we will affect a full refund. In all other circumstances No Fees = No Football.
